ARTICLE SUMBISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PAYMENT PROCEDURE

- 1. The articles should strictly follow the standards and regulations outlined in this regulation and should be submitted in the following fields:
 - ➤ Management and Economics
 - ➤ Law (Jurisprudence)
 - Philology
 - ➤ Information Technologuies
- 2. The articles in the scientific collection are adjusted to the fields outlined in point 1.
- 3. The scientific collection is published both in printed and electronic versions at least twice a year, and comprises up to 250 pages.
- 4. Admittedly, **40%** of the published articles should be submitted by the authors who have a scientific title or degree.
- 5. Annualy, 10% of the materials in the collection are published in English.
- 6. The electronic version of the published collection is posted on the official website of the collection www.eua-collection.am.
- 7. After publication, the collection is delivered to the National Book Chamber of Armenia, the National Library of Armenia, other professional-scientific libraries and archieves.
- 8. Materials supported by EUA and additional releases are not equated with this collection.
- 9. The publication of articles is carried out on a free or paid basis.
- 10.EUA employees, doctoral students, postgraduate students, researchers and masters submit their articles free of charge.

- 11. The cost of 1 printed page is 3000 AMD. The value of all pages of the article submitted for publication is equal, regardless of the volume of the material.
- 12.Each author of the article is given a free copy of the collection. The cost of each additional copy of the collection is 5000 AMD.
- 13. The author(s) must pay the amount within 3 working days from the moment receiving the payment notice. Payment notice is sent only to the author(s) of the articles accepted for publication.
- 14.Payments must be made by bank transfer to the university-specified account. In the latter case, the author either mails the receipt to journal@eua.am or submits it to the accounting department within the time frame outlined in point 13.
- 15. Article authors are not compansated.
- 16.Articles are sent to the editing office in both printed and electronic formats using the "MS Word" text editor. The electronic version must be supplied by email to journal@eua.am.
- 17. Master's students may submit an article with the co-authorship of an expert with a degree in the relevant subject only.
- 18.Postgraduate students and research applicants submit their articles with a written assurance from their scientific advisor.
- 19.Articles must be submitted by the stipulated date in the application announcement. Articles submitted after the deadline are considered for the subsequent issue.
- 20. The collection includes dates for article submission, review, and publishing.
- 21. The collection is published with the approval of the EUA's scientific council.
