

COLLECTION PUBLICATION ARRANGEMENT

1. The Editorial Council organizes the preparatory tasks and the process of publishing the journal under the direction of the chief editor.
2. The journal's official editor-in-chief is the rector of EUA. The list of Editorial Council members established by Scientific Council records are approved by the rector of EUA.
3. The Rector of EUA issues orders for the formation, revision, and dissolution of the Editorial Council in accordance with the EUA Scientific Council's decisions.
4. The Editorial Council works with nominated scientists and researchers in Armenia and around the world who have doctorates and scientific qualifications. The Editorial Council should include at least two doctors of sciences and one doctor of philosophy in the relevant field. Members of the Editorial Council are not Members of the editorial board are not permitted to serve on the editorial boards of four or more local periodicals at the same time.
5. The editorial board is responsible for ensuring the scientific novelty of the materials published in the collection, the availability of references for borrowed ideas and claims in the materials, and the maintenance of publishing ethics.
6. In the previous five years, at least 10% of the editorial council must have published a scholarly article in the «Scopus» or «Web of Science Core Collection» (Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE), Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI)) corpuses and periodicals.
